

Predné Solisko (peak), 2117 m

Easy access: 1 1/4 hour from Štrbské Pleso.

Easy return: 30 min. via existing red-marked trail to two mountain huts and to cableway.

The advantage of Štrbské pleso location:

- train (from two directions),
- car, bus (a lot of parking slots),
- lodging capacity.



Predné Solisko ferrata - basic informations I.


- Execution: 1 year (just 5 6 months because of High Tatras weather)
- . Length: 650 m
- Elevation: 400 m
 - start point near waterfall "Skok" (aka Jump in english) at 1700 m
 - target point near peak Predné Solisko at 2100 m
- . Difficulty: easy/moderate, B/C





Equipment estimation:


- Steel cable 600 m length
- Iron rungs (stemples) 1 200 pieces
- Anchors for steel cable 240 pieces
- One "nepalese bridge" 12 m length
- Total cost limit: max 100 000 €







